This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.438 dated 06.09.2015, under Sections 148/149/302/120-B IPC and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Panipat, District Panipat.

Vide orders dated 22.04.2016, 02.06.2016 & 03.06.2016 passed in CRM-M-12609-2016, CRM-M-17452-2016 and CRM-M-19021-2016, co-accused of the petitioner namely Narender, Pardeep and Dharampal have been granted regular bail by this Court. Aforesaid FIR was registered on the statement made by Saddam in relation to an occurrence which took place on 06.09.2015, wherein Aszad, nephew off the complainant, had died. As per the version of the complainant, on 06.09.2015, when he along with

deceased-Aszad, Mukrim and Imran were sitting in the fields at about 11.30

A.M., six boys came in two different cars i.e. Swift and Punto and they were indicating towards the land. When deceased-Aszad went close to them and made inquiries, an exchange of hot words took place. Thereafter, two boys took out pistols and fired shots towards Aszad, who succumbed to the injuries.

The petitioner was arrested on 05.10.2015. His name was disclosed by Dharampal in an extra judicial confession.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, has informed that a discharge report dated 15.03.2016 has been made qua Dharampal.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.
