FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. are that on 21.4.2016 from the illegal possession of the petitioner 10 injections of Buprenorphine each of 2 ml. and injection of Avil of 10 ml. were recovered, thus, a non-commercial quantity.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since more than 08 months and the factual aspect of recovery is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since long time and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present

petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
