Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.105 dated 08.06.2015, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District S.A.S.Nagar, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 498-A and Sections 3, 4 & 18 of The Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (which were added later on).

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar has informed that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 02.02.2016. As per offence punishable under Sections 3, 4 & 18 of The Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, which were added later on, he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 28.01.2016 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
