Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.161 dated 24.06.2016, under Sections 420, 120-B, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No. 7, Jalandhar, the accused as well as the complainant have arrived at compromise (Annexure P-2) in order to live in peace and harmony.

In view of the fact that petitioners have returned the entire money to the complaint which fact has been accepted by learned counsel for the complainant, in view of the further fact that statements have been recorded by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar and forwarded to this Court through District & Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, wherein it is stated that compromise having been arrived at between the parties is found to be genuine, without any pressure or coercion.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.161 dated 24.06.2016, under Sections 420, 120-B, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No. 7, Jalandhar, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
