Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.68 dated 05.02.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani, Haryana, under Sections 302, 148, 149, 201, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 09.02.2015 and prays that he be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has stated that the prosecution evidence is almost concluded and only one official witness remains to be examined and the matter is fixed before the learned trial Court for 30.09.2016.

As only one official witness remains to be examined, who is stated to have given his testimony on 30.09.2016, therefore, in these circumstances, the instant petition stands dismissed. However, in case, the

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official prosecution witness does not appear before the learned trial Court to give his testimony on 30.09.2016 then the learned trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail on the said date.
