By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of her arrest, in case bearing FIR No.233, dated 23.07.2016, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Tripari, District Patiala, during the pendency of trial.

Vide order dated August 24, 2016, at the time issuance of notice of motion, petitioner was granted interim relief with direction to join the investigation and further that in the event of her arrest, she shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Despite the fact that she was granted the concession of interim bail, she did not comply with the terms and conditions of that order and has

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not approached the Investigating Officer to join the investigation. Not only this, subsequent thereto, on October 19, 2016, petition was adjourned for today and interim order was made to continue. Despite that fact, she has failed to comply with the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

In the given circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that such a person does not deserve the concession of interim relief.
