This is second application for grant of bail, first having been disposed of on 08.02.2016 with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that period of six months has elapsed.

With the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file.

The petitioner was involved in the case on the basis of secret information. He allegedly escaped from the spot while his co-accused Ramandeep and Kamaljit Singh were arrested with 100 grams of intoxicating powder, on the basis of secret information. 100 grams of intoxicating powder left in the car allegedly belonged to the petitioner.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe here that the petitioner has been in custody since 16.10.2015. Having not been arrested from the spot, his identity and possession will be a debatable issue during course of trial.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
