JASPAL SINGH, J

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. petitioner has sought bail in case FIR No. 21, dated April 19, 2016, under Sections 306 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bareta, Tehsil Budhlada, District Mansa.

Undisputably, the name of the petitioner did not figure in the FIR and no specific role has been attributed to her, which ultimately drove the deceased to commit suicide. The allegations, if any, are against Kewal Singh and Pargat Singh. The names of the petitioner as well as Veerpal Kaur, her co-accused, figured in the supplementary statement made subsequently on May 19, 2016. The petitioner was arrested in this case on May 20, 2016 and since then, she is suffering incarceration. Veerpal Kaur, co-accused who is similarly situated has already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated August 23, 2016 passed in CRM No.M-27956 of 2016.

Taking into consideration the above-said facts but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
