In FIR No.114 dated 03.07.2016, under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, petitioner was arrested on 05.07.2016 and is in jail since then.

Looking to the fact that the offences are triable by the Magistrate and further fact that by this time, investigation must have been completed, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence and threaten the prosecution witnesses.
