This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.335 dated 26.06.2016, registered under Sections 323/506/34 IPC and Sections 3/33/89 of SC/ST Act, at Police Station Manesar, District Gurgaon.

On the last date following contention was noticed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per his information the parties have compromised the matter and seeks an adjournment.”

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from A.S.I. Ram Parkash states that it has been verified that the matter has been settled.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
