The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of F.I.R. No.43 dated 02.08.2015 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Sanaur, District Patiala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

On 22.04.2016 the following order was passed :-
