This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take strict/stern action against the respondent Nos.5 to 10 and to register a criminal case on the basis of complaint dated March 04, 2016 (Annexure P-8) and also to protect the life & liberty of the petitioner & her family members.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Jind (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in her representation dated March 04, 2016 (Annexure P-8).

The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Jind (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in her representation dated March 04, 2016 (Annexure P-8) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case, there is threat perception, respondent No.3 shall provide necessary protection to the petitioner and her family members.
