Petitioner-Harinder Pal Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case No.37 of 2015 under Sections 419/420/465/471 of IPC pending before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Bharat Kumar, Advocate has appeared and filed memorandum of appearance on behalf of the complainant and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone

through the record.

From the record, first of all, I find that it is a complaint case in which present petitioner has been summoned by the Court under Sections 419 and 420 IPC etc.

Moreover, in pursuance of the interim order dated 26.08.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody. He is only to face the trial by appearing before the trial Court.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 26.08.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
