The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.40 dated 10.04.2016 registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur, for the offence punishable under Section 304-B and 120B IPC and alternate charge framed by the learned trial Court for the offence under Section 306 IPC.

The co-accused of the petitioner i.e. Rani Kaur has been granted regular bail vide order dated 16.08.2016. As per dying declaration of the deceased (Annexure P-1), on the day of occurrence, her husband fought with her and never used to do any work. She (deceased) poured kerosene oil on herself and burnt herself. It is further stated that her husband, mother-in-law and father-in-law all used to trouble her. In the FIR it is also stated that husband of the deceased was a drug addict and did not do any work.

As per instructions of ASI Harmeet Singh, learned state counsel submits that out of 24 witnesses, 2 witnesses have been examined.

Learned counsel for the complainant has appeared and states that one private witness i.e. father of the deceased has still to be examined.

In view of the facts mentioned above and considering the fact that trial would take time to its conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail subject to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Sangrur.
