Petitioners are no doubt involved in other cases but they have been granted the concession of bail in the other cases. Petitioners were involved in the present case registered at the instance of Pragat Singh alleging that on 20.12.2015, his brother while going in a car was attacked by 3-4 unknown persons, on account of which the vehicle had gone out of control and thereafter, he was robbed of his wallet contained Rs.3000/- and other cards. The petitioners have been connected with the crime on the basis of their confessional statements made in another FIR.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that no witness has been examined till date, though petitioners have been in custody with effect from 23.12.2015. In view of the material gathered, the evidentiary value of the disclosure statements, made by the petitioners in other FIR, will be a debatable issue.

The petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be

released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that they will not indulge in any activity of similar nature as alleged in the present petition during the pendency of the trial. In case of any such eventuality, it will be open to the prosecution agency to seek cancellation of bail.
