Prayer is under section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.118 dated 16.07.2015 for offences punishable under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar and the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-2).

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the complainant has filed affidavit of the complainant stating therein that the terms of the compromise have not been adhered to and, therefore, he is not willing to give his no objection qua quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

In view of the above, present petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise is hereby dismissed.
