The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 27.06.2016 registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The only allegation against the petitioner is that he was waiting outside for the arrival of the robbers who had entered the house of the complainant for committing robbery and fled away with them on motorcycle.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 24.08.2016 the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order of previous date the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 24.08.2016 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
