Learned Counsel for the petitioner has filed a photocopy of the affidavit of the complainant which is taken on record and marked as 'X' for identification on the complete risk and consequences of the petitioner.

In view of the said fact that the complainant Manpreet Singh is an NRI living in Lisbon and unable to come back and in the light of the offences registered against him and the nature of the offences and further the judgment of acquittal in respect of co-accused persons, I think by way of compounding/compromise the FIR as well as the consequential proceedings are required to be quashed. Consequently, the impugned FIR along with all consequential proceedings is quashed. Interim order dated 17.10.2016 is made absolute.
