Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner did not appear before the trial Judge, who was granted time of 15 days to appear earlier on 19.04.2016, in case FIR No.88 dated 24.07.2014, registered under Section 452, 323, 324, 325, 34 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Bullowal, District-Hoshiarpur. By impugned order dated 20.07.2016, the trial Court declined to grant him any further extension.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was unwell and, therefore, could not appear before the trial Judge. He also states that, henceforth he will not commit any mistake of not appearing and would continue to appear with promptitude.
