The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.52 dated 30.01.2016, registered under Sections 306 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Jagadhri, Distt. Yamuna Nagar.

Contents that no case for abetment is made out in the instant case. The son of the deceased, namely, Amar Singh, had been committing thefts in the house of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2016. Co-accused, Manoj Kumar, has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the instant petition. On instructions, learned State counsel informs that the challan stands presented and out of eighteen prosecution witnesses, five have been examined. He further informs that the petitioner is involved in

three more FIRs.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody since 30.01.2016. Out of eighteen prosecution witnesses, only five have been examined so far, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the conclusion of the trial may take time.

Keeping in view the above, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, anything noticed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
