Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Lakhwinder Kaur alleging that the property of her grand father Hazara Singh has been fraudulently transferred during pendency of the civil suit.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Court under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C., for petitioner having committed offence under Section 82 of the Registration Act.

On the instructions of ASI Gulzar Singh, it has been informed that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

This appears to be a case where the right, title and interest of the parties in the property of Hazara Singh are to be determined on the basis of the litigation which is pending inter se the complainant and the petitioner and others.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 26.8.2016, is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
