Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.41 dated 30.06.2016 under Sections 323, 324/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur.

This Court vide order dated 26.08.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/ Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 26.08.2016, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Bhupinder Singh, submits that in terms of aforesaid order, petitioners have joined

investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 26.08.2016 are made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
