Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 27.04.2016 in a case registered at the instance of Surinder Pal alleging that the petitioner along with his wife Asha Rani, Sohan Lal and Shiv Kumar have cheated the complainant for a sum of Rs. 2,70,000/-. He was duped as they had told him to sell their house to the complainant. Petitioner and others have neither returned the money nor handed over the possession of the house to the complainant.

The application for regular bail has been dismissed on the ground that petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender.

Since the petitioner has been in custody with effect from 27.04.2016 and no witness having been examined till date, he can be granted the concession of bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered

to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will join investigation as and when required and will not absent himself without any sufficient cause.
