This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under
Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.17 dated 20.03.2016 registered under
Sections 307, 392, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act at
P.S. Rure Ke Kalan, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injury which is attributed to
the petitioner was simple in nature and other similarly situated co-accused has

been granted anticipatory bail.

Learned Addl. A.G. is not in a position to deny this fact.

In this circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case I do not deem it appropriate to dismiss the petition. Resultantly, the petition is allowed.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 09.09.2016 or any other date as and when his presence is required. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he will be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
