Petitioner, Man Singh, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.150 dated 01.07.2016, registered at Police Station Hasanpur, District Palwal, under Sections 420, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, co-accused, Jagmal, has been apprehended red handed from the spot. The allegation against the present petitioner is that he is also involved with co-

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accused, Jagmal. There are allegations that complaints have been received to the effect that in the garb of sanction of house and money for constructing toilets, non-applicant, Jagmal, was taking money and on his asking, the present petitioner had come to take money from Beena.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 26.08.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation, as argued. He is now not required for custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 26.08.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
