The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 36 dated 25.02.2015 registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali under Sections 302, 304-B, 406, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR but a supplementary statement was given on the next day and he was named. He also states that the petitioner was in his office.

The bail application has been opposed by the complainant as well as the State counsel. It is stated that the petitioner was named in the FIR and the translation given is not correct.

The couple had got married in 2011. The postmortem report does not show any injury. The death was on account of poisoning. The incident took place between 2.30 and 3.00 p.m. The girl was taken to the hospital within 15 minutes. The petitioner is in custody since 24.04.2015.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude and the additional accused have been summoned, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
