Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents for registration of case in terms of authority Lalita Kumari v. Government of U.P. and others (2014)1 SCC (CrI.) 524, and to conduct investigation by way of constituting Special Investigation Team (SIT) outside the jurisdiction of Batala police. The petitioner has some complaints.

I am of the view that in case the complainant has some grouse, it is always open for him to move to the police for taking action and if no action is taken, it is always open to the complainant to move before the Illaqa Magistrate with a criminal complaint and

there, request may be made under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. for giving direction for registration of the case. It is for the Illaqa Magistrate to consider as to what directions are to be given in view of Lalita Kumari's case (supra). As such, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the present petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate and make appropriate prayer.
