Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioner No.1 is major and residing with family members of petitioner No.2 with her own free Will. The petitioner No.2 is also reached at the age of discretion. He cites **Neelam Rani and another** Vs. **State of Haryana and others**, 2011(1) RCR (Civil) 636. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the

instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-SSP, Bathinda, to take necessary action on the representation dated 23.08.2016 (Annexure P-5) moved by petitioner No.1 and provide necessary protection to the petitioners, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8, in accordance with law.
