The petitioner has been in custody, w.e.f. 22.06.2016, on the allegation that 300 grams of intoxicant powder had been recovered from him in an FIR No. 117, dated 22.06.2016 under Sections 399, 402 and 472 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act read with Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.

On the instructions of ASI Malkiat Singh, it has been

informed that though the challan has been presented, but the report of the Chemical Examiner has not been received till date.

In view of the absence of any report regarding chemical composition of the powder alleged to have been recovered from the petitioner, he can be granted the concession of interim bail.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court till the receipt of the report of Chemical Examiner without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to seek the concession of regular bail on receipt of the report of Chemical Examiner.
