This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.94 dated 29.07.2013, registered at Police Station Mukeriain, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition. Police record has also been produced.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the petitioner has been named in the FIR. He was stated to be armed with deadly weapon i.e. *Datar*. He caused injuries to complainant-Sukhwinder Singh and his brother-Balwinder Singh.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from ASI Avtar

Singh has submitted that three injuries given by the present petitioner to

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Balwinder Singh have been declared grievous and one injury which was given on the vital part of the body i.e. head, has been declared dangerous to life.

The impugned order dated 11.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur shows that earlier, the present petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
