Petitioner-Sandeep has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.261 dated 17.06.2016 registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. B.S.Virk, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has not been named in the FIR; nor any injury has been attributed to him. The present petitioner has been nominated in this case on the disclosure statement of main accused-Pardeep. The petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of

the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
