This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent Nos. 5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states FIR No.38 dated 08.03.2016, under Sections 354-A, 447 and 506 IPC (Annexure p-1) was registered against respondent No.7. Thereafter, a counter FIR (Annexure P-3) has been got registered by the private respondents against the wife and minor children of the petitioner. Apprehension of the petitioner is that a fair investigation will not be carried out as respondent No.7 is having close relations with respondent No.5 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Ropar. In this regard, a detailed representation dated 10.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) has been made to the Additional Director General of Police (Crime) Punjab-

respondent No.4.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Additional Director General of Police (Crime) Punjab-respondent No.4 to look into the representation dated 10.05.2016 (Annexure P-7) and conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law.
