This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of direction to official respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to investigate the matter and register an FIR against private respondents Nos.6 to 11 under Sections 420/494/498-A/406/120-B/34 IPC.

Marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Jinderpal-respondent No.6 on 24.12.2014 at village Khera, Phagwara. As per marriage certificate (Annexure P-1), it was a registered marriage. After marriage, the petitioner came to know that respondent No.6 was already married to one Balwinder Kaur, who was residing at Amritsar, and was having 4/5 children, as is evident from copy of the ration card (Annexure P-2). After sometime, the petitioner was thrown out of her matrimonial house. In this regard, a complaint dated 06.04.2016 (Annexure P-3) was made to respondent No.3. The respondents are pressurizing the petitioner to

compromise the matter.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala-respondent No.3 to look into the complaint/representation dated 06.04.2016 (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
