By virtue of this instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioners have sought issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty at the hands of respondent No.5.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that petitioners are being called time and again by the S.H.O., Police Station Kotwali, Patiala and are being made to sit in the police station.

Learned counsel further contends that the police is presurring upon the petitioners to part with some money, that too, without any complaint preferred by respondent No.5 against the petitioners.

However, during the arguments, it has emerged that no representation has been moved so far by the petitioners either to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala or any other senior police officer against the act and conduct of the S.H.O. concerned.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the petitioners to first to move respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala detailing all the facts and circumstances within a period of one week, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala within a period of one month from the date of filing of representation. However, if the petitioners still feels aggrieved, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
