The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.248 dated 05.08.2016, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 382, 392, 364 IPC.

On 27.08.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion for 21.09.2016.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on

interim bail by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and they shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Rajesh Chauhan, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 27.08.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
