The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR

No.94, dated 9.5.2013, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468,

471, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines,

Ludhiana.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Kumar, states that the petitioner has again joined the investigation but the original Will has yet not been handed over.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was the transferee and, therefore, there was no occasion for him to have the original Will.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition is allowed and the order dated 28.1.2016 is made absolute.
