The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.46 dated 27.06.2016 registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Kotbhai, District Muktsar Sahib.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The only allegation against the petitioner is that he was waiting outside for the arrival of the robbers who had entered the house of the complainant for committing robbery and fled away with them on motorcycle.

On the last date of hearing this Court had asked the State counsel that whether there is any case pending against him. The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, by way of one opportunity to the petitioner not to indulge in any such offence, I think the relief of anticipatory bail should be granted to him.

Hence, the petition for anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in this case, on furnishing of bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
