Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439
Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.40 dated 07.06.2016, registered
at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, under Section 304
IPC.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner and the
deceased were friends and both were drug addicts. The petitioner took the
deceased with him. Lateron, on inquiry, the petitioner told the wife of the
deceased that the deceased was lying in the fields where his dead body was

discovered and at that time there was a syringe in his vein and his arm had been tied.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner is in custody since 15.06.2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 15.06.2016 and without commenting on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
