The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.52 dated 17.04.2016, registered at Police Station Gate Hakiman, Amritsar, under Sections 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act read with Section 61 of the Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than 04 months and till date FSL report has not come and prays that the petitioner be released on interim bail till the receipt of the FSL report.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from ASI Parminder Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to release the petitioner on interim bail to its

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satisfaction till the receipt of the FSL report and thereafter shall decide the
issue of confirmation/vacation thereof on merits.
