Petitioners have approached this Court by way of petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 to proceed in the case i.e. cross case registered vide Report No.21 Roznamcha dated 15.6.2015, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kurali, District Mohali (Section 326 IPC added later on) (Annexure P-4) in FIR No.98 dated 15.6.2015, under Sections 307, 452, 324, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kurali, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 20.5.2016 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.2 but no action thereof has been taken so far. He submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to

respondent No.2 to look into the contents of the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case but taking into consideration the representation dated 20.5.2016 (Annexure P-6) allegedly made by the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of the said representation and to act in accordance with law.
