This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.87 dated 16.12.2015, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station, City-1, Mansa.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Manjit Singh, has informed the Court that three *tolas* of gold has since been recovered from the petitioner.

A perusal of FIR (Annexure P-1) shows that during enquiry, Rakesh Kumar, Superintendent of Police, had found that there was no evidence with regard to demand of dowry and the complainant did not produce any bills regarding the dowry articles.

In view of the said fact, the order 28.01.2016 passed by this

Court, is made absolute.
