of a truck of which both the petitioner and the complainant are claiming

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 11.09.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
