Petitioner is allegedly involved in a case registered at the instance of DSP, Yogi Raj pertaining to leakage of examination paper for the post of Inspector Grade-I and II and other posts. The petitioner was found to have worked as a conduit for Dinesh Yadav and allegedly enticed many prospective candidates desirous of getting jobs as Inspector Grade-II and taken them to Lucknow where they were shown question papers on receipt of money.

The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 07.07.2016. Recoveries have already been effected. Despite police remand of seven days, no recovery was effected from the petitioner. Culpability of the petitioner as a member of gang will certainly be a debatable issue. Similarly circumstanced co-accused of the petitioner

has been granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali.
