SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has remained in detention for a long time now since his arrest on 29.06.2016. Two of his co-accused have been granted bail by the co-ordinate bench in CRM-M-No.29180 and 30611 of 2016. The only additional implicating circumstance against the petitioner is that fire arm(double barrel 12 bore gun) along with ammunition was recovered from his possession, which was not the case in respect of the other accused. It is also submitted that two empty cartridges as well were recovered from the spot thereby indicating that it was the petitioner who had fired at the police party.

Be that as it may, the fact of the matter is that admittedly, no injury has been sustained by any one in the given circumstances.

Therefore, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he may be released on bail on appropriate terms and conditions as may be deemed fit by the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
