The relief claimed in the present petition was to allow the petitioner to sit in the Final B.Sc.(Medical) examination which was to be held on 2.4.2002 and declaration of the result as a regular candidate.

Vide order dated 1.4.2002, the petitioner was granted interim relief of appearance in the above said final examination subject to further orders. Thereafter, on 1.4.2003 the respondent no.1-University was directed to declare the result of the petitioner of final B.Sc. (Medical) Examination subject to the final adjudication of the writ petition. After that the writ petition was admitted on 10.7.2003 and the direction was issued to issue detailed marks certificate to the petitioner pertaining to his B.Sc. final examination subject to further orders.

It is pointed out by the petitioner himself that thereafter migration certificate has been granted by the University on 8.9.2008. In the meantime, he has also done his Bachelor of Education from the Panjab University in the year 2004 and had studied the said course at Rayat Institute of Education, Railmajra, Nawanshahar. It is further his case that

he has also done Master of Science (Chemistry) from the Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Mullana-Ambala in the year 2013.

Photocopies of the above certificates have also been placed on record.

The response of the University at that point of time was that the petitioner had been registered with three Universities and therefore, there was a violation regarding migration of the student.

Now a period of more than 1-1/2 decade has gone by and the petitioner has further improved his qualification. It is case of the petitioner that on the basis of the said qualification he has got employment and presently he is working as Post-Graduate Teacher (Chemistry) with the Haryana Government.

In such circumstances, even if the objection of the University is to be upheld, it would be highly inequitable to put the clock back at this point of time.

Resultantly, the interim orders are confirmed and the present writ petition is disposed of.
