This second petition under Section 438 of Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.29 dated 10.02.2015 registered under Sections 420, 465, 471, 467, 468 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had sold the stamp paper to co-accused Paramjit Singh who has misused the same. The petitioner does not have any criminal background. The petitioner caused appearance before the trial Court which issued summons to make statement which is reflected in Annexure P-5.

But the submissions have already been considered by this Court in the detailed order dated 29.01.2016. The reiteration of the same cannot be said to be a favourable circumstance in favour of the petitioner.

The only ground on which the present application is filed is that challan has been filed but there is no change in facts on situation and the

same material is available before this Court as was available on earlier occasions. It cannot be a ground to grant concession of bail to present petitioner.

Considering the fact that the order dated 29.01.2016 was passed on merits and no case for interference is made out.

Petition stands dismissed.
