Petitioner Hardeep Kaur is wife of Lachhman Singh who is an accused in a case FIR No.23 dated 25.04.2016 under Section 15 of the NDPS Act. The petitioner had allegedly made a complaint against the police to Chief Minister, Punjab during Sangat Darshan in the area of Mehal Kalan claiming that her husband has been falsely implicated and that on account of said complaint, she will be harmed by the police. Copy of the representation made to the Chief Minister, has been placed on record as Annexure P-2.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Ms. H.K. Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala will look into the grievance of the petitioner as mentioned in Annexure P-2. In case, copy of Annexure P-2 has not been sent by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police,

Barnala, it will be open to the petitioner to file a fresh complaint which would be looked into within a period of two months after the submission of the same. The petitioner will also not be harassed by frequently calling her to police station. In case, her presence is required in a case she being not an accused, she would be required to issue a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.
