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**JASPAL SINGH, J.**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of direction to respondents to hand over the investigation/inquiry of application dated 24.09.2014 (Annexure P-2) preferred by the petitioner to Economic Offences Wing for fresh inquiry.

2. In response to the issuance of notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Prabhjot Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar has already been filed on behalf of the respondents.

3. A glance at the aforesaid reply transpires that during inquiry, the allegations levelled by the petitioner have been found false, frivolous and baseless. Moreover, there is no cause/ground for getting the matter re-inquired

through Economic Offences Wing as the police officers are also well-versed to inquire into such matter(s).

4. In view of the inquiry report, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to him under law.
