Report from the JMIC, Moga, has been received in this regard. As per

report, respondent No.2-Sunaina and her mother respondent No.3-Raj Rani and accused-petitioners appeared before the trial Court on 27.09.2016 for getting their statements recorded in support of the compromise. In this regard statements of respondent No.2-Sunaina and her mother respondent No.3-Raj Rani and accused-petitioners were recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and respondent No.2-Sunaina and her mother respondent No.3-Raj Rani have no objection if the present FIR is quashed against these accused/petitioners. Statements of accused-petitioners were also recorded to the same effect. In view of separate statements of the parties, the Court is satisfied that the compromise is valid and genuine one.

Consequently, in view of the status report and the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.73 dated 07.05.2014, for the offence under Sections 323, 354, 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
