JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No. 207 dated April 21, 2014 under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2 Vide order dated December 01, 2015, parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, for getting their statements

recorded. In compliance thereof, report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Assandh has been received, wherein, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties without any fear or pressure and the same appears to be genuine. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in cases reported as ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another***; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 and ***Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another (2014) 6 SCC 466***, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 207 dated April 21, 2014 under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 506 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua petitioners.
